Working with European partners, PRIAE is undertaking this ground-breaking project aimed at helping non-EU highly skilled migrant workers integrate into the UK workplace and find work that appropriate reflects their skills and experience. Initial research with employers, recruitment agencies and migrant workers has been undertaken to identify problems facing this target group and many of the pitfalls they encounter in the job-seeking process. Building on this knowledge, the project team are developing manuals and a portfolio that can be used by recruitment/placement agencies and migrant workers to help them enter the skilled job market and get work that reflects their skills and experience. The project will promote the business case for equality and diversity in a Diversity Management Manual which will be widely circulated to employers in the UK. 50 migrant job-seekers will be given personal assistance and will be able to attend a free training course to upgrade their job prospects.
